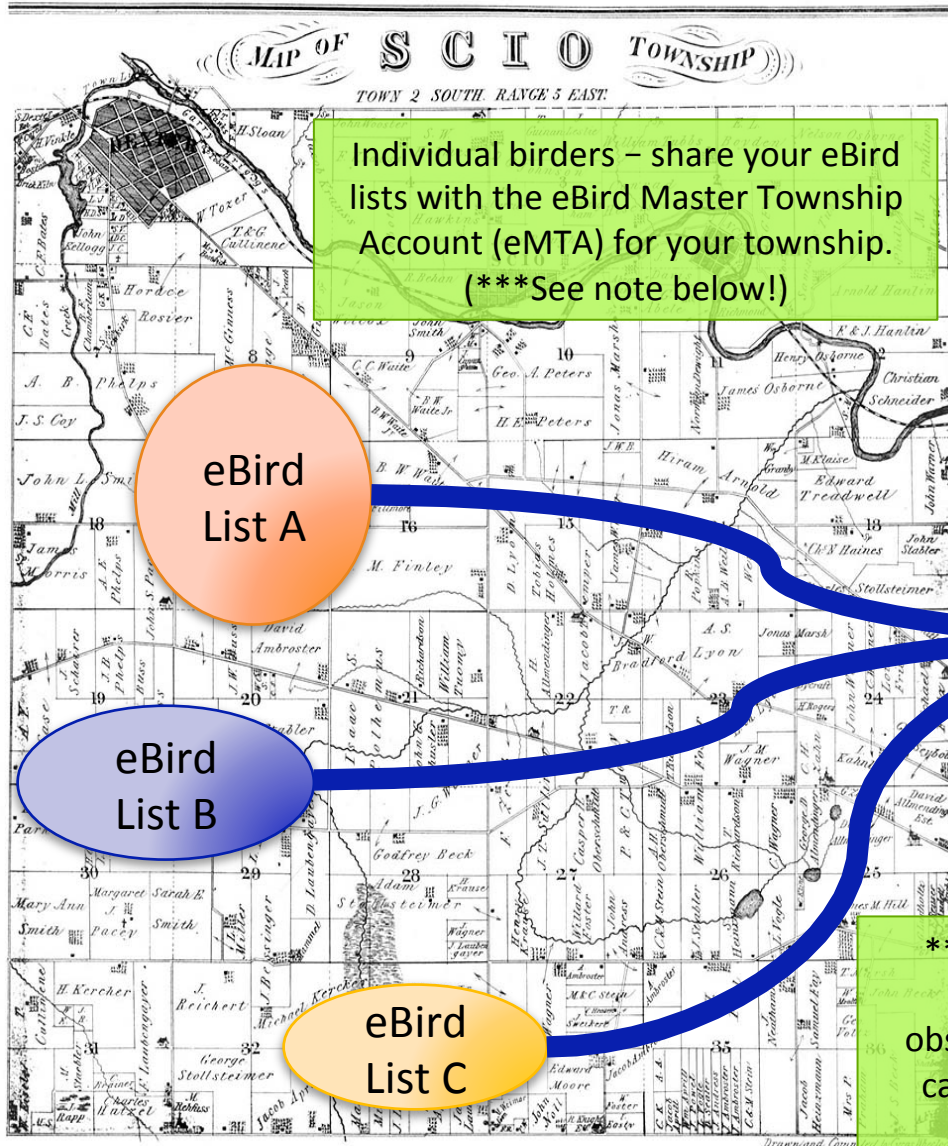


# Washtenaw County *May Count* with eBird

A Simplified Procedure – Updated April 14<sup>th</sup>, 2020

# Some Preliminaries

- We have created eBird Master Township Accounts (eMTAs) for each Township and also a County-wide eBird Account.
- We will provide printable tally sheets, sorted both alphabetically and by taxonomy (taxonomy based on early-2018 rules).
- We will provide a *Rare Birds List* with information on how to document these birds. (*Please take photos and get audio if you can!!*)
- Please enter all data using eBird, unless special arrangements are made. Please put your Township eMTA name in comments of your lists.
- Area Leaders should provide maps with clear boundaries for coverage by their team members.
- Any corrections to an eBird List must be made in all three accounts: the individual's, the eMTA, and the County's, so let everyone in the team has accurate and updated information.
